## 9. Call for Papers, Reports, and Studies

All participants are invited to submit papers on the identified themes above. Full paper should be submitted by June 25, 2010. A panel of experts will select those papers to be presented at the conference. Recent studies and research which have highly contribution to the existing knowledge in the areas of education are among the major considerations in the selection. Only accepted papers for presentation will be compiled into the official conference proceedings. In particular, the conference encourages the following types of submissions:

- **Research Papers**

Completed research papers in any of the topic areas listed above or related areas.

- **Review Papers**

Papers addressing latest issues, policies and practices related to the identified themes above which are based on metaanalytic studies.

- **Work-in-Progress Reports or Proposals for Future Research**

Incomplete research or ideas for future research in order to generate discussion and feedback in any of the topic areas listed above, or related areas.

- **Reports on Issues Related to Teaching**

Reports related to innovative instruction techniques or research related to teaching in any of the topic areas listed above or related areas.

## 10. Guidelines on Submission of Paper

Full paper must include, in the main body of the document, a title, names and affiliations of all authors. A postal address, telephone number and e-mail address for at least one contact author are also required. The abstract should not exceed 150 words. The paper should be 5,000- 8,000 words including references, notes, and tables. The font must be Times New Roman, only the title must be in 14pt font, centered and in bold. The rest of the text must be in 12pt and justified. The name and affiliations of all authors (including the details of the contact author) must be centered, but not in bold or italics. All submissions should conform to the consistency of your own referencing styles, please choose one of these referencing styles: Publication Manual of the APA, 5th edition; Chicago 15th Referencing Style; Harvards Referencing Style; MLA Referencing Style; and Turabian Reference List.

**11. Publication** : Keynote speech and papers from every session will be published in the form of a proceeding paper to received on the first day of conference. For this purpose, **papers should be submitted by e-mail attachment to *durgus2000@yahoo.com* by June 30, 2010.**
